



## Moberly School District children eat Free!

All Moberly area children ages 1-18 will be able to eat free starting Monday, September 14<sup>th</sup> through the end of December, or as long as federal funding is available. This includes one breakfast and one lunch per school day Monday through Friday per child. Enrolled in-seat students will be provided meals on school days during regular meal service times.

Carry out meals for children not enrolled in-seat at Moberly School District will be available for pick up at Moberly High School and must be pre-ordered weekly.

- Meals can be picked up at Moberly High School for any child ages 1-18.
- Meals must be pre-ordered weekly.
- Pre-ordering starts Thursday, September 10<sup>th</sup>.
- You must submit your pre-order for the next week by Friday at 10:00 am.
- To pre-order meals complete the survey form on our website. If you are unable to submit your order online, you may call the school secretary to place your order.
- Meals can be picked up each Monday between the hours of 10:00 am – 12:00 pm at Moberly High School.
  - Drive through line at High School: Enter the main drive and drive toward the kitchen door on the North side of the building, just East of the Weight Room door.
- One breakfast and one lunch will be provided for each day school is in session that week. If we are in session Monday-Friday, five-day bulk meals will be provided for the week. This includes five days of breakfast meals and five days of lunch meals. If we are scheduled in session for 2 days that week, two days of meals will be provided.
- This program ends Tuesday, December 22<sup>nd</sup> or earlier if federal funding is no longer available. Two days of meals will be provided for the week of Monday, December 21<sup>st</sup>.

If you have not already completed a free/reduced meal application for the 2020/2021 school year, we do encourage families to do so. We will return to our regular food service program in January and students will be charged again for meals unless they qualify for free meals.
